

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI, TO ENTER INTO AN “EQUITABLE SHARING AGREEMENT AND CERTIFICATION” WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

WHEREAS, the ATF NITRO Task Force has successfully seized property and money during their investigations. The United States Attorney’s Office has filed asset forfeiture proceedings against the seized property and money. A portion of these proceeds come back to the Cameron Police Department to be used to purchase law enforcement equipment.

WHEREAS, the Asset Forfeiture Branch of the Department of Justice requires an annual report be submitted by participating agencies on the amount of money the department has received and how it has been spent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the Equitable Sharing Agreement which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to the Mayor’s signature.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
