

RESOLUTION 2013-5

DECLARATION OF WATER SHORTAGE ALERT FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cameron, Missouri finds raw water supplies to be consistently below seasonal averages and if they continue to decline we will no longer meet the normal need.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Water Superintendent shall, on a daily basis, monitor the supply and demands upon the raw water supplies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to impose a ban on the following Social or Economically Important Uses of Water (Class 2): outdoor, non-commercial watering; water hauling for non-domestic use; outdoor commercial or public watering; and, ban all non-essential (Class 3) water uses for the duration of the shortage or until the City Council has declared it ended.
