A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CAMERON, MISSOURI POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT A 100%, NON-MATCHING, GRANT FROM THE MISSOURI POLICE CHIEFS CHARITABLE FOUNDATION FOR MOBILE DATA TERMINALS FOR PATROL VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the Missouri Police Chief's Association has been expanding the ability of member agencies to have mobile data technology in patrol vehicles within the State. This program is made available to member agencies via a 100%, non-matching, competitive grant; and

WHEREAS, our department has applied twice for MDT's in the last few years. We were successfully in this cycle of grants and have been awarded four (4) MDT's. The grant value, including equipment and installation, is \$25,228; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance of this grant will allow our department to have mobile data connectivity in our patrol vehicle with the State of Missouri Uniform Law Enforcement System, Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) and Records Management System (RMS). This will allow our officers to have information literally at their fingertips while on the scene of any call for service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cameron, Clinton and DeKalb Counties, Missouri that the City Council fully supports, approves and authorizes the Cameron Police Department and City Manager to execute any and all documents pertaining to the acquisition of the grant for the awarded mobile data terminal equipment from the .
