

A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI STATING INTENT TO WITHDRAW FROM THE EMPLOYEE BENEFITS PROGRAM WITH MIDWEST PUBLIC RISK (MPR)

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Cameron, Clinton and DeKalb Counties, Missouri, to withdraw from the Midwest Public Risk (MPR) “Employee Benefits Programs” effective June 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the MPR Bylaws require “A member may withdraw from membership in MPR Missouri as of the end of MPR Missouri’s fiscal year provided that such Member has given at least ninety (90) days prior written notice” and that this notice must be adopted by the governing body of the member.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Cameron, Clinton and DeKalb Counties, Missouri formally places MPR on notice of its intent to withdraw from the “Employee Benefits Programs” effective June 30, 2013.
