

Resolution 2013-16

**A RESOLUTION ELIMINATING A WATER SHORTAGE ALERT  
AND DECLARING A WATER SHORTAGE ADVISORY FOR THE  
CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DEKALB COUNTIES,  
MISSOURI**

**WHEREAS**, the City water supply has recovered to the point where conservation measures for the Alert Phase are no longer necessary, and

**WHEREAS**, City ordinance requires Council action by Resolution to declare that the Alert Phase for water conservation no longer exists, based on measured water levels, and

**WHEREAS**, the first, Advisory phase is now warranted.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Cameron, Clinton and DeKalb counties, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Cameron authorizes the City Manager to enact the Advisory phase of the ordinance. If supplies deplete, the next phase, which is the Alert phase will be presented to Council by Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution for the Advisory phase shall become effective upon the date of its adoption.
