

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A THREE-PARTY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF MISSOURI, HDR ENGINEERS AND THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI WITH RESPECT TO NATIONAL PRIMARY DRINKING WATER REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron owns and operates a water supply, treatment and distribution system as a stand-alone non-profit municipal enterprise to serve the citizens of Cameron; and

WHEREAS, the system must maintain sustainability of operations, which includes watershed protection; and

WHEREAS, the revenue received by the City must be sufficient to treat and deliver water to customers, therefore making periodic reviews of our rates necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a Three-Party Agreement between the State of Missouri, HDR Engineers and the City of Cameron with respect to the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations all as per the agreement attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to sign documents ancillary to the agreement.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to the Mayor’s signature.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
