

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI AND THE BUREAU OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES (ATF) NORTHWEST MISSOURI INTERAGENCY TEAM RESPONSE OPERATION (NITRO) TASK FORCE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron has been a supporter of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) Northwest Missouri Inter-Agency Team Response Operation (NITRO) Task Force since its inception in October 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) entered into a Space Occupancy Agreement (Interagency Agreement), dated June 25, 2010 with the City of Cameron; and

WHEREAS, ATF has requested, per the agreement, to exercise the option for successive terms for office space; and

WHEREAS, all additional terms agreed upon in the June 25, 2010, Space Occupancy Agreement will remain in effect; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that continuation of the Space Occupancy Agreement is desirable and beneficial to both ATF and the City of Cameron.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign an Interagency Agreement which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to sign this ordinance on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force with a January 1, 2014 effective date after its passage and approval.
