The City Council of the City of Cameron, Missouri met in Special Session on Monday, the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 2014, at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall. Mayor Dennis M. Clark led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

Mayor Dennis M. Clark presided with the following Councilmembers present: Jerri Ann Eddins, Ronnie Jack and William B. Rose-Heim. Absent: Darlene Breckenridge.

Present were City Manager Mark Gaugh, Attorney for the City Mitch Elliott and City Clerk/Finance Clerk Barbara J. O'Connor.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Bill 2014-19, AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON 8 APRIL 2014, FOR COUNCILMEMBERS, IN THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI, was read by title by City Clerk O'Connor. Copies of said Bill 2014-19 were available for the public. Motion was made by Councilmember Rose-Heim and seconded by Councilmember Eddins to pass said bill on first reading. Discussion. A total of 1,261 votes were cast with Dennis M. Clark receiving 630 votes and Jerri Ann Eddins receiving 602 votes. There were 29 write in votes cast. Bill 2014-19 declares the election results and directs that Mr. Clark and Ms. Eddins be commissioned as Councilmembers. Motion carried. Absent: Councilmember Breckenridge.

Motion was made by Councilmember Eddins and seconded by Councilmember Rose-Heim to suspend the rules and place said bill on second reading. Discussion. None. Motion carried. Absent: Councilmember Breckenridge.

On motion made by Councilmember Jack and seconded by Councilmember Rose-Heim said bill was placed on second reading, was read by title and passed by the following roll call vote: "Aye": Councilmembers: Clark, Eddins, Jack and Rose-Heim. "Nay" none. Absent: Councilmember Breckenridge. The Mayor thereupon declared said bill duly adopted and said bill was numbered **ORDINANCE 5822**, was thereupon signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

Oath of Office. City Clerk O'Connor administered the oath of office to Dennis M. Clark and Jerri Ann Eddins.

Election of Mayor and Mayor Pro-Tem. City Clerk O'Connor entertained nominations for election of Mayor. Councilmember Jack nominated Councilmember Clark. There were no other nominations. Councilmember Clark was elected Mayor by a voice vote. Absent: Councilmember Breckenridge.

Mayor Clark entertained nominations for election of Mayor Pro-Tem. Councilmember Rose-Heim nominated Councilmember Jack. There were no other nominations. Councilmember Jack was elected Mayor Pro-Tem by a voice vote. Absent: Councilmember Breckenridge.
