

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI TO ENTER INTO AN AVIATION PROJECT CONSULTANT SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT No. 1 WITH H. W. LOCHNER, INC., TO PERFORM PROFESSIONAL CONSTRUCTION OBSERVATION SERVICES FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT CAMERON MEMORIAL AIRPORT, PROJECT #AIRE 13-0113A-1**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cameron has been approved for Non-Primary Entitlement grant money to make improvements at the Cameron Memorial Airport, by the Missouri Department of Transportation, Aviation Department; and

**WHEREAS**, this project includes necessary pavement maintenance; and

**WHEREAS**, an agreement was entered into on September 11, 2013, with H. W. Lochner, Inc, for design of the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City now desires to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to otherwise complete, extend or continue the Original Agreement for Construction Observation Services as provided in the Agreement.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an Aviation Project Consultant Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with H. W. Lochner, Inc to perform professional construction services for airport improvements at Cameron Memorial Airport, with a total cost of this project not to exceed \$24,575.00 all as per the agreement attached hereto and made apart hereof.

Section 2. City Manager is hereby authorized to sign any ancillary documents as necessary.

Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign this Ordinance on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.
