

**A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE SURPLUS A 1974
INTERNATIONAL MOBILE COMMAND UNIT AND A 1989
INTERNATIONAL BRUSH-TANKER TRUCK OWNED BY THE
CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES,
MISSOURI, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF SUCH
PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, The City of Cameron chooses to remove old or obsolete items from inventory from time to time; and

WHEREAS, one (1) 1974, International Mobile Command Unit, VIN: 30330CHN12335, is no longer of useful service to the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, one (1) 1989, International Brush-Tanker Truck, VIN: 1HTLFZZN9KH613823, is no longer of useful service to the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron has determined it would be in the best interest of the City to declare said property as surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron has a Surplus Property Policy which requires City Council action on items over one-thousand dollars in value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cameron, Clinton and DeKalb Counties, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. The 1974 International Mobile Command Unit, is hereby declared surplus property.

Section 2. The 1989 International Brush-Tanker Truck is hereby declared surplus property.

Section 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to sell said property:

Section 4. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to attest to the Mayor's signature for all of the documents evidenced in this Resolution.
