**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF UNITED FIBER DEVELOPING A GIGABIT COMMUNITY FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI**

**WHEREAS**, at the February 2, 2015 Council meeting, a presentation was made by a representative of United Fiber, explaining the benefits of fiber broadband installation within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Communications Commission has called for gigabit broadband services in all fifty states by 2015, which is a community benefit for individual users, as well as businesses, along with the promotion of economic development; and

**WHEREAS**, United Fiber has the capability and local presence to provide gigabit service to Cameron.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council for the City of Cameron, Clinton and DeKalb Counties, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. The City of Cameron supports United Fiber developing the City of Cameron as a gigabit community.
