The City Council of the City of Cameron, Missouri met in Special Session on Monday, the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April 2015, at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall. Mayor Dennis M. Clark led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

Mayor Dennis M. Clark presided with the following Councilmembers present: Darlene Breckenridge, Jerri Ann Eddins, Ronnie Jack and William B. Rose-Heim. Absent: none.

Present were City Manager Mark Gaugh, Attorney for the City Mitch Elliott and City Clerk/Finance Clerk Barbara J. O'Connor.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Bill 2015-15, AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON 7 APRIL 2015, FOR COUNCILMEMBERS, IN THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI, was read by title by City Clerk O'Connor. Copies of said Bill 2015-15 were available for the public. Motion was made by Councilmember Rose-Heim and seconded by Councilmember Jack to pass said bill on first reading. Discussion. A total of 830 votes were cast with Darlene Breckenridge receiving 335 votes, Ronnie Jack receiving 298 votes and Frank A. Buck receiving 189 votes. There were 8 write in votes cast. Bill 2015-15 declares the election results and directs that Darlene Breckenridge and Ronnie Jack be commissioned as Councilmembers. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Councilmember Breckenridge and seconded by Councilmember Eddins to suspend the rules and place said bill on second reading. Discussion. None. Motion carried unanimously.

On motion made by Councilmember Jack and seconded by Councilmember Eddins said bill was placed on second reading, was read by title and passed by the following roll call vote: "Aye": Councilmembers: Breckenridge, Clark, Eddins, Jack and Rose-Heim. "Nay" none. The Mayor thereupon declared said bill duly adopted and said bill was numbered **ORDINANCE 5877**, was thereupon signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

Oath of Office. City Clerk O'Connor administered the oath of office Darlene Breckenridge and Ronnie Jack.

Election of Mayor and Mayor Pro-Tem. City Clerk O'Connor entertained nominations for election of Mayor. Councilmember Breckenridge nominated Councilmember Eddins. Councilmember Jack nominated Councilmember Clark. There were no other nominations. Councilmember Breckenridge and Councilmember Eddins cast voice votes for Councilmember Eddins. Councilmember Clark, Councilmember Jack and Councilmember Rose-Heim cast voice votes for Councilmember Clark. Councilmember Clark was elected Mayor.

Mayor Clark entertained nominations for election of Mayor Pro-Tem. Mayor Clark nominated Councilmember Jack. Councilmember Breckenridge nominated Councilmember Eddins. There were no other nominations. Councilmember Clark, Councilmember Jack and Councilmember Rose-Heim cast voice votes for Councilmember Jack. Councilmember Breckenridge and Councilmember Eddins cast voice votes for Councilmember Eddins. Councilmember Jack was elected Mayor Pro-Tem.
