

Resolution 2015-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI, TO CONTINUE INSURANCE COVERAGE FROM UNITED HEALTHCARE THROUGH THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR AND OBTAIN VISION AND DENTAL COVERAGE FROM STANDARD INSURANCE COMPANY

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron partners with its employees for insurance coverage; and

WHEREAS, the City will continue coverage with United Healthcare for a 15 month period, making it coincide with the City's fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the new deductible amounts and out-of-pocket amounts will increase for the employee, but an option is available for employees to "buy up" to a higher coverage plan if they desire to do so; and

WHEREAS, the employee contribution for dependent coverage will change from 50% to 60%, and the employee's share for the employee's coverage will remain at 10%; and

WHEREAS, vision and dental insurance coverage will be provided by Standard Insurance Company, resulting in lower costs to the employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council for the City of Cameron, Clinton and DeKalb Counties, Missouri that the City will continue with United Healthcare through the next fiscal year.
