

A BILL FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI AUTHORIZING A DOG GROOMING OCCUPATION THROUGH CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR TRILLIAN TELLER AT 524 NORTH CHESTNUT STREET

WHEREAS, on July 8th, 2015 Trillian Teller submitted a Petition for a Dog Grooming Occupation through Conditional Use Permit at 524 N. Chestnut street; and

WHEREAS, public notice regarding the above petition was published in the *Cameron Citizen-Observer*, a newspaper of general circulation, on July 23, 2015. A Public Hearing concerning said matter was held at City Hall in Cameron Missouri at 6:00 p.m. on August 10, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Cameron Planning and Zoning Commission has met; considered said request and voted, (4) Four YES, (0) Zero NO and (1) One abstention on recommending approval of the permit by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Article 31, Conditional Uses, of the Cameron Zoning Ordinance, petitioner Trillian Teller is hereby granted a Conditional Use Permit for dog grooming at 524 N. Chestnut Street.

Section 2. The Petitioner shall at all times observe the following conditions:

- 1) Days of operation: Monday through Saturday;
- 2) Hours of operation: 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.;
- 3) Paid employees: None;
- 4) Kennel use - Dog grooming only with no other services incidental to a kennel allowed.

Section 3. The Mayor is authorized to sign this ordinance approving it on behalf of the City.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
