

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI AND THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, MISSOURI STATE PARKS, FOR A RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM PROJECT AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION & EXPANSION OF THE CAMERON RESERVOIR MULTI-USE TRAIL

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron submitted a grant application for construction and expansion of a multi-use trail to include a bridge, trailhead parking, and restroom renovations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron was successful in its application and was awarded a grant in the amount of \$191,180.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City of Cameron, a Project Agreement attached hereto and made a part hereof, with the Missouri State Parks hereby accepting the grant monies, pursuant to the Project Agreement, and hereby agrees to make said improvements.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances therefore enacted which are in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. City Manager is hereby authorized to sign any ancillary documents as necessary.

Section 4. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign this Ordinance on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
