

A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI ACCEPTING THE BID FOR A SPRAY INJECTION PATCHING TRAILER MACHINE FROM DURACO, INC.

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron has determined the need for a patching machine, advertised for bids; and

WHEREAS, a total of two bids were received and reviewed by Staff with Duraco, Inc., as the low bid at \$48,315; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Cameron does hereby accept the bids relating to the purchase of a spray injection patching trailer machine, pursuant to bid specifications, and hereby awards the bid to Duraco, Inc. for the purchase of a DuraPatcher Model 125DJT machine in the amount of \$48,315.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption and authorizes the City Manager to purchase said machine.

Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign this Resolution on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.
