

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE PUBLIC ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI, ON 5 APRIL 2016; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO IMPOSE A SALES TAX FOR FIRE PROTECTION PURPOSES ON RETAIL SALES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cameron, Clinton and DeKalb Counties, Missouri, under the authority of powers given to the City by the provisions of Section 321.242, RSMo, as amended (the “Act”), has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to impose a city sales tax for the operation of the municipal fire department of the City at the rate of one-fourth of one percent (1/4 of 1%) on the receipts from all retail sales within the City which are subject to taxation under Sections 144.010 to 144.525, inclusive, RSMo, with the intention that the revenues generated from such sales tax supplement the City’s general fund revenue that is otherwise annually appropriated for fire protection purposes.

WHEREAS, no ordinance imposing a sales tax pursuant to the Act shall be effective unless the City Council submits to the voters of the City a proposal to authorize the imposition of the tax, and a majority of the voters approve such proposal; and

WHEREAS, an election was held April 5, 2016 and the results are hereby declared.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It is hereby found and declared that the vote at the election held in the City of Cameron, Missouri, on Tuesday, April 5, 2016, on the following question:

QUESTION

“Shall the City of Cameron, Clinton and DeKalb Counties, Missouri, impose a sales tax at a rate one-fourth of one percent (1/4 of 1%) for the purpose of providing revenues for the operation of the municipal fire department, said sales tax to terminate 20 years from the date on which such sales tax becomes effective?”

Resulted as follows:

Section 2. It is hereby found and declared that said election was duly held and conducted in conformity with the constitution and statutes of the State of Missouri, and in all respects regular and valid, that a majority of the qualified voters voting on said question at said election voted in favor of the imposition of said sales tax, and that the City is duly authorized and empowered to impose said sales tax in the amount and for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. The said sales tax approved by the voters as described above shall be deemed to apply to all sales of metered water services, electricity, electrical current and natural, artificial or propane gas, wood, coal or home heating oil for domestic use only.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
