The City Council of the City of Cameron, Missouri met in Special Session on Monday, the 11th day of April 2016, at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall. Mayor Dennis M. Clark led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

Mayor Dennis M. Clark presided with the following Councilmembers present: Darlene Breckenridge, Jerri Ann Eddins and Ronnie Jack. Absent: Lynn Rogers.

Present were City Manager Mark Gaugh and City Clerk/Finance Clerk Barbara J. O'Connor.

NEW BUSINESS

Bill 2016-18, AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON 5 APRIL 2016, FOR COUNCILMEMBERS, IN THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI, was read by title by City Clerk/Finance Clerk O'Connor. Copies of said Bill 2016-18 were available for the public. Motion was made by Councilmember Breckenridge and seconded by Councilmember Eddins to pass said bill on first reading. Discussion. A total of 929 votes were cast with John R. Feighert receiving 497 votes, Lynn Rogers receiving 385 votes and Frank A. Buck receiving 47 votes. There were no write in votes cast. Bill 2016-18 declares the election results and directs that John R. Feighert be commissioned as Councilmember. Motion carried. Absent: Councilmember Rogers.

Motion was made by Councilmember Jack and seconded by Councilmember Eddins to suspend the rules and place said bill on second reading. Discussion. None. Motion carried. Absent: Councilmember Rogers.

On motion made by Councilmember Jack and seconded by Councilmember Eddins said bill was placed on second reading, was read by title and passed by the following roll call vote: "Aye": Councilmembers: Breckenridge, Clark, Eddins and Jack. "Nay" none. Absent: Councilmember Rogers. The Mayor thereupon declared said bill duly adopted and said bill was

numbered **ORDINANCE 5926**, was thereupon signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

Oath of Office. City Clerk/Finance Clerk O'Connor administered the oath of office to John R. Feighert.

Election of Mayor and Mayor Pro-Tem. City Clerk/Finance Clerk O'Connor entertained nominations for election of Mayor. Councilmember Breckenridge nominated Councilmember Eddins. Councilmember Feighert nominated Councilmember Breckenridge. There were no other nominations. Councilmember Eddins was elected Mayor by a unanimous voice vote.

Mayor Eddins entertained nominations for election of Mayor Pro-Tem. Councilmember Feighert nominated Councilmember Breckenridge. There were no other nominations. Councilmember Breckenridge was elected Mayor Pro-Tem with a unanimous voice vote.

Bill 2016-19, AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE PUBLIC ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI, ON 5 APRIL 2016; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO IMPOSE A SALES TAX FOR FIRE PROTECTION PURPOSES ON RETAIL SALES, was read by title by City Clerk/Finance Clerk O'Connor. Copies of said Bill 2016-19 were available for the public. Motion was made by Councilmember Breckenridge and seconded by Councilmember Feighert to pass said bill on first reading. Discussion. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Councilmember Jack and seconded by Councilmember Clark to suspend the rules and place said bill on second reading. Discussion. None. Motion carried unanimously.

On motion made by Councilmember Breckenridge and seconded by Councilmember Jack said bill was placed on second reading, was read by title and passed by the following roll call vote: "Aye": Councilmembers: Breckenridge, Clark, Eddins, Feighert and Jack. "Nay" none. The Mayor thereupon declared said bill duly adopted and said bill was numbered **ORDINANCE 5927**, was thereupon signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk/Finance Clerk.
