

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI REPEALING THE CURRENT ELECTRIC RATES AND ESTABLISHING NEW ELECTRIC RATES FOR CONSUMERS OF THE CAMERON MUNICIPAL UTILITIES

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron owns and operates an electrical distribution system as a stand-alone non-profit municipal enterprise to serve the citizens of Cameron, and

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron has a full service contract with Platte-Clay Electric Cooperative for power supply; and

WHEREAS, Platte-Clay Electric Cooperative will be instituting a rate increase on purchased power starting on May 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the revenue received by the City for the sale of electricity must be sufficient to purchase and deliver electricity to customers and maintain a reliable distribution system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Repeal the existing subsection (b) and (c) of Sec. 12-321, Residential service schedule (R-1), and replace it with a new subsection (b) and (c), setting new electric rates.

(b) *Net Rate.* This schedule is subject to the power cost adjustment clause in Section 12-329 of this division.

First 40 kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.1885
Next 960 kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.1134
Excess kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.0918

(c) *Net minimum.* The total net monthly bill calculated on the rates established in (b) of this section, shall not be less than seven dollars and fifty-four cents (\$7.54).

Section 2. Repeal the existing subsection (b) and (c) of Sec. 12-321a, Residential with electric heat service schedule (R-2), and replace it with a new subsection (b) and (c), setting new electric rates.

(b) *Net Rate.* This schedule is subject to the power cost adjustment clause in Section 12-329 of this division.

First 40 kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.1885
Next 960 kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.1134
Excess kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.0836

(c) *Net minimum.* The total net monthly bill calculated on the rates established in (b) of this section, shall not be less than seven dollars and fifty-four cents (\$7.54).

This rate shall apply to energy usage during the months October through May. Otherwise the rates from residential service schedule R-1 will apply.

Section 3. Repeal the existing subsection (b) and (c) of Sec. 12-322, Commercial service schedule (SC-1), and replace it with a new subsection (b) and (c), setting new electric rates.

(b) *Net Rate.* This schedule is subject to the power cost adjustment clause in Section 12-329 of this division.

First 50 kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.1885
Next 1,150 kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.1134
Next 1,800 kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.0948
Excess kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.1035

(c) *Net minimum.* The total net monthly bill calculated on the rates established in (b) of this section, shall not be less than nine dollars and forty-three cents (\$9.43).

Section 4. Repeal the existing subsection (b) and (c) of Sec. 12-322a, Commercial with electric heat service schedule (SC-2), and replace it with a new subsection (b) and (c), setting new electric rates.

(b) *Net Rate.* This schedule is subject to the power cost adjustment clause in Section 12-329 of this division.

First 50 kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.1885
Next 1,150 kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.1134
Next 1,800 kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.0856
Excess kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.0930

(c) *Net minimum.* The total net monthly bill calculated on the rates established in (b) of this section, shall not be less than nine dollars and forty-three cents (\$9.43).

This rate shall apply to energy usage during the months October through May. Otherwise the rates from residential service schedule SC-1 will apply.

Section 5. Repeal the existing subsection (b) and (c) of Sec. 12-324, Large commercial service schedule (LC-1), and replace it with a new subsection (b) and (c), setting new electric rates.

(b) *Net Rate.* This schedule is subject to the power cost adjustment clause in Section 12-329 of this division.

First 100 hours use of metered demand, per kWh.....	\$0.1507
Next 200 hours use of metered demand, per kWh.....	\$0.0772
Excess kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.0700

(c) *Net minimum.* The total net monthly bill calculated on the rates established in (b) of this section, shall not be less than the metered demand kW times the minimum bill demand charge (nine dollars and forty-three cents (\$9.43)/kW).

Section 6. Repeal the existing subsection (b) and (c) of Sec. 12-324a, Large commercial with electric heat service schedule (LC-2), and replace it with a new subsection (b) and (c), setting new electric rates.

(b) *Net Rate.* This schedule is subject to the power cost adjustment clause in Section 12-329 of this division.

First 100 hours use of metered demand, per kWh.....	\$0.1204
Next 200 hours use of metered demand, per kWh.....	\$0.0772
Excess kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.0700

This rate shall apply to energy usage during the months October through May. Otherwise the rates from residential service schedule LC-1 will apply.

(c) *Net minimum.* The total net monthly bill calculated on the rates established in (b) of this section, shall not be less than the metered demand kW times the minimum bill demand charge (seven dollars and fifty-two cents (\$7.52)/kW).

Section 7. Repeal the existing subsection (b) and (c) of Sec. 12-325, Industrial service schedule (PL-1), and replace it with a new subsection (b) and (c), setting new electric rates.

(b) *Net Rate.* This schedule is subject to the power cost adjustment clause in Section 12-329 of this division.

First 100 hours use of metered demand, per kWh.....	\$0.1836
Excess kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.0653

(c) *Net minimum.* The total net monthly bill calculated on the rates established in (b) of this section, shall not be less than the metered demand kW times the minimum bill demand charge (eleven dollars and eighty-four cents (\$11.84)/kW).

Section 8. Repeal the existing subsection (b) and (c) of Sec. 12-325a, Industrial service with electric heat schedule (PL-2), and replace it with a new subsection (b) and (c), setting new electric rates.

(b) *Net Rate.* This schedule is subject to the power cost adjustment clause in Section 12-329 of this division.

First 100 hours use of metered demand, per kWh.....	\$0.1481
Excess kWh, per kWh.....	\$0.0653

This rate shall apply to energy usage during the months October through May. Otherwise the rates from residential service schedule PL-1 will apply.

(c) *Net minimum.* The total net monthly bill calculated on the rates established in (b) of this section, shall not be less than the metered demand kW times the minimum bill demand charge (eight dollars and twenty-eight cents (\$8.28)/kW).

Section 9. This ordinance hereby repeals all other ordinances pertaining to all electric rates heretofore established for electric users in the City of Cameron, Missouri, and any and all other ordinances inconsistent herewith. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force June 1, 2016.

Section 10. The Mayor is authorized to sign this ordinance approving it on behalf of the City.

Section 11. The City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.
