

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE PUBLIC ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI, ON 2 AUGUST 2016; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO CONTINUE APPLICATION AND COLLECTION OF THE LOCAL SALES TAX ON THE TITLING OF MOTOR VEHICLES, TRAILERS, BOATS, AND OUTBOARD MOTORS THAT WERE PURCHASED FROM A SOURCE OTHER THAN A LICENSED MISSOURI DEALER

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cameron, Clinton and DeKalb Counties, Missouri, under the authority of powers given to the City by the provisions of Section 144.757, RSMo, has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to continue application and collection of the local sales tax on the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and outboard motors that were purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer.

WHEREAS, the City is required under the provisions of Section 32.087 RSMo to submit to the qualified voters of the City the question of repealing the application of the local sales tax to the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and outboard motors that were purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer; and

WHEREAS, an election was held August 2, 2016 and the results are hereby declared.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It is hereby found and declared that the vote at the election held in the City of Cameron, Missouri, on Tuesday, August 2, 2016, on the following question:

QUESTION

“Shall the City of Cameron continue applying and collecting the local sales tax on the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and outboard motors that were purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer?”

Resulted as follows:

Section 2. It is hereby found and declared that said election was duly held and conducted in conformity with the constitution and statutes of the State of Missouri, and in all respects regular and valid, that a majority of the qualified voters voting on said question at said election voted in favor of the continuation and imposition of said sales tax, and that the City is duly authorized and empowered to impose said sales tax.

Section 3. The local sales tax shall apply to the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats and outboard motors that were purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
