

A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LEASE-PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH BARNES BAKER AUTOMOTIVE GROUP FOR TWO (2) 2017 FORD EXPLORER POLICE UTILITY VEHICLES FOR THE CAMERON POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the current utility vehicles being replaced are dedicated to the Detective Division (2001 Chevy Suburban) and the Chief of Police (2004 Dodge Durango). Reliability has become an increasing concern with these vehicles due to their age, mileage, increasing maintenance issues and body integrity due to rust; and

WHEREAS, during the budget planning process and subsequent budget approval a cost center was approved for the lease-purchase of two (2) replacement SUVs for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Staff requested and has received bids for new utility vehicles for the Cameron Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council for the City of Cameron, Clinton and DeKalb Counties, Missouri that the City Manager is authorized to enter into a lease-purchase agreement with Barnes Baker Automotive Group for two (2) 2017 Ford Explorer Police Utility Vehicles.
