

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON, DeKALB AND CALDWELL COUNTIES, MISSOURI TO ACCEPT PROPERTY LOCATED ALONG GROAT STREET; AND, ALONG EIGHTH STREET AS PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cameron recently completed design for the Groat Street reconstruction project requiring additional right-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, there are a total of five properties with signed conveyance of right of way deeds located along Groat Street and Eighth Street, more particularly described in the attached Exhibits, and marked as Michael R. and Margaret E. Zieber, 611 North Groat; Robert E. Petersen, 615 North Groat; Jerel L. and Angela C. Williams, 709 North Groat; Rosa Maxine Shaw, 711 North Groat; Francee Virts and Christian Virts, 722 North West St; and the City of Cameron Water Plant, West Eighth Street; and

**WHEREAS**, in the City of Cameron desires to accept the property as permanent public right-of-way to enhance public convenience and safety.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON, DeKALB AND CALDWELL, COUNTIES, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept Conveyance of Right of Way from Michael R. and Margaret E. Zieber, 611 North Groat; Robert E. Petersen, 615 North Groat; Jerel L. and Angela C. Williams, 709 North Groat; Rosa Maxine Shaw, 711 North Groat; Francee Virts and Christian Virts, 722 North West St; and the City of Cameron Water Plant, West Eighth Street as permanent right-of-way, copies of which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign this Ordinance on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to the Mayor’s signature and to record said documents.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
