

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON, DeKALB AND CALDWELL COUNTIES, MISSOURI TO ACCEPT PROPERTY FROM THE FOREMAN FAMILY TRUST LOCATED ALONG OAK AVENUE; AND, ALONG WEST THIRD STREET AS PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission for the City of Cameron on July 10, 2017 approved the lot split for applicant Chad Foreman; and

WHEREAS, the lot split would include future development for multifamily housing, the lot split was recorded with the Recorder of Deeds, Clinton County, Missouri on July 18, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the current location of the road radius along the north-east corner of Third Street and Oak Avenue is off-centered and does not align continuously. Therefore, the Foreman Family Trust (owner) is willing to dedicate approximately 0.12 acres along Third Street and Oak Avenue to the City for permanent public right-of-way to allow for public infrastructure improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron desires to accept the property, specifically described in Exhibit A and Exhibit B. The permanent public right-of-way will allow for placement and maintenance of public infrastructure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON CLINTON, DeKALB AND CALDWELL COUNTIES, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to record the attached exhibits as permanent right-of-way.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign this Ordinance on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
