

RESOLUTION 2018-27

**A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE CITY MANAGER TO INITIATE
THE PROCESS OF OBTAINING EMERGENCY WATER FOR THE
CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI**

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron's raw water supply is approaching the 40% level, which is the Emergency Phase of the Water Conservation Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City's water emergency plan includes a temporary raw water pumping line running from Pony Express Lake to Grindstone Lake as authorized by the Missouri Department of Conservation; and

WHEREAS, the City has been granted permission to pump for a period up to 180 days and

WHEREAS, Staff needs the flexibility to expend necessary funds and schedule work for installation of the emergency water line to Grindstone Lake as soon as water levels indicate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council for the City of Cameron, Missouri as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to expend funds and make the necessary purchases for the pipeline.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to sign this Resolution approving it on behalf of the City.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.
