**A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI TO PROCEED IN THE PURCHASE OF A GENERAL STEEL BUILDING FOR THE ANIMAL SHELTER, THE BUILDING IS A FORTY FOOT WIDE BY EIGHTY FOOT LONG STRUCTURE TO SERVE AS THE NEW FACILITY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cameron, City Staff under the direction of City Council has researched and reviewed the preliminary documents for said building; and

**WHEREAS**, City Staff and River Bluff Architect has coordinated the efforts for the design and location of a forty foot wide by eighty foot long structure to be placed within the City of Cameron; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Steel Building shall be fully functional and complete as presented and used thereafter; and

**WHEREAS**, City Staff recommends the approval to acquire the General Steel Building, forty foot wide by eighty foot long to serve as the new facility the (Animal Shelter).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council for the City of Cameron, Missouri as follows:

Section 1. The Community Development Director is authorize to proceed in obtaining the new animal shelter.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to sign this resolution approving it of behalf of the city.
