

Resolution 2018-39

**A RESOLUTION ELIMINATING A WATER SHORTAGE EMERGENCY  
AND DECLARING A WATER SHORTAGE ADVISORY FOR THE CITY  
OF CAMERON, MISSOURI**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cameron has adopted voluntary and mandatory water conservation measures in the event a water shortage is declared; and

**WHEREAS**, the City water supply has recovered to the point where conservation measures for the Emergency Phase are no longer necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, City ordinances require Council action by Resolution to declare the Emergency Phase for water conservation no longer exists; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Cameron, Missouri finds raw water supplies to still be below seasonal averages.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Cameron, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Cameron authorizes the City Manager to enact the Advisory Phase of the water conservation ordinance and call upon all water customers to employ voluntary water conservation measures and eliminate the waste of water for the duration of the shortage or until the City Council has declared it ended.

Section 2. This resolution repealing the Emergency Phase and enacting the Advisory Phase shall become effective upon the date of its adoption.

Section 3. The Mayor is authorized to sign this Resolution approving it on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.
