

Resolution 2018-42

**A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI TO SUPPORT THE MISSOURI MAIN STREET PROGRAM'S AFFILIATE GRANT APPLICATION, SUPPORTING THE 60/40 SHARED COST, 40% BEING THE CITY PORTION TO THE MISSOURI MAIN STREET CONNECTION IN THE CITY'S REVITALIZATION EFFORTS**

**WHEREAS**, On September 5, 2018, Resolution 2018-32 was passed in support of the Missouri Main Street Connection Affiliate Grant application; and

**WHEREAS**, With the support of the Mayor and City Council, the City of Cameron agrees to the 60/40 shared cost to the Missouri Main Street Program's Affiliate Grant as part of the application requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Cameron, Missouri understands the importance of revitalizing the downtown district to spur economic growth opportunities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Cameron, Missouri that the City of Cameron agrees to the terms for the Missouri Main Street Program's Affiliate grant opportunity as follows:

Section 1. The City of Cameron, Missouri agrees to fully participate in the efforts to revitalize the downtown district in cooperation with the community. The City hereby endorses the local downtown revitalization efforts and the Main Street Four-Point Philosophy established by the National Main Street Center to revitalize the downtown district. By endorsing participation in the grant, the City also understands that downtown revitalization is a partnership between Missouri Main Street Connection, the City, and the private sector.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to sign this Resolution approving it on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.
