**A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI
SUPPORTING THE CAMERON POLICE DEPARTMENT'S EFFORTS TO
IMPROVE RECRUITING AND EMPLOYEE RETENTION**

WHEREAS, the City has a Police Department with an impeccable reputation for service to the community; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide the Police Department with all necessary tools and funds to continue to be a successful agency; and

WHEREAS, Police Department salaries have become a hindrance to their ability to attract and retain quality employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby supports the Cameron Police Department's efforts in resolving issues regarding the ability to attract and retain quality employees and directs the Interim City Manager to seek additional funding to assist their efforts.

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the Interim City Manager, City Counselor, and other appropriate City Staff to take all such further actions as may be necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. The Mayor is authorized to sign this Resolution approving it on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
