

**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI  
AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON 2 APRIL  
2019, FIXING THE POLLING PLACES OF SAID ELECTION, AND  
DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO CAUSE BALLOTS TO BE PRINTED  
AND ELECTION SUPPLIES PROCURED FOR SAID ELECTION**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON,  
MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The General Municipal Election will be held on 2 April 2019, in Clinton and DeKalb Counties. The Caldwell County section of the City of Cameron has no registered voters therefore no election is required in Caldwell County.

Section 2. The qualified voters of said City, Clinton County, shall vote at the Cameron Public Safety Building, 101 West Second Street, and the qualified voters of said City, DeKalb County, shall vote at 1<sup>st</sup> Cameron State Bank North Branch, lower level, 515 Platte Clay Way.

Section 3. The ballots for said General Election will be printed and provided at the polling places in substantially the following form:
