

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH E. L. CRAWFORD CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR A BUILDING EXPANSION PROJECT AT THE CAMERON PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron Fire Department has determined the need to expand the size of the Cameron Public Safety Building; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron has solicited construction bids for the expansion located at 101 West Second Street and did receive ten bids; and

WHEREAS, the Cameron Fire Department, Cameron City Staff, and Ellison-Auxier Architects, Inc. having review all bids received and determined E. L. Crawford Construction, Inc. has met all the requirements, provided all necessary documents, and was the lowest and best bid with the total bid of \$293,022.00, recommends the approval of an construction contract with E. L. Crawford Construction, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON, DeKALB, AND CALDWELL COUNTIES, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an contract with E. L. Crawford Construction, Inc. for construction expansion at the Cameron Public Safety Building, 101 West Second St. as per the agreement attached hereto and made apart hereof.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute ancillary documents and change orders necessary to effect this transaction.

Section 3. The Mayor is authorized to sign this ordinance on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
