

**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI,
APPOINTING THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THE MISSOURI
MAIN STREET CONNECTION ORGANIZATION WHICH SHALL BE
CHARGED WITH OVERSEEING THE DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION
EFFORTS TO PROMOTE GROWTH AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**

WHEREAS, in 2018, the City of Cameron was rewarded an Affiliate Grant through the Missouri Main Street Connection which is a 60/40 service grant to provide services; and

WHEREAS, as part of the requirements, the City of Cameron must form a Board of Directors to oversee and regulate the efforts of the downtown revitalization; and

WHEREAS, a notice was published in the *Cameron Citizen-Observer*, a newspaper of general circulation, on January 17, 2019; and

WHEREAS, applications for board members were received and reviewed by City Staff and members of the Economic Development Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board of Directors for the Missouri Main Street Connection shall be formed by the approval of the City Council as follows:

2. Steve Rasmussen (Ex-Officio Member)
3. Economic Development Consultant (Ex-Officio Member)
4. Dixie Masters
5. Katherine Hahn
6. Jordan Assel
7. Quinten Lovejoy
8. Denise Maddex
9. Tara Wallace

Section 2. Each member shall be responsible for abiding by the rules and regulations provided by the Missouri Main Street Connection attached in Exhibit A. Each member shall serve on the board as volunteers of the community and in good faith. The Mayor shall be responsible for enforcing the rules and regulation of each board member. Each member shall serve at the pleasure of the City Council.

Section 3. The Mayor is authorized to sign this ordinance approving it on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
