

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH LUKE KUSH'S PAINTING, INC, FOR HANGAR RENOVATION IMPROVEMENTS AT THE CAMERON MEMORIAL AIRPORT, RELATED TO PROJECT No. 18-013A-1

WHEREAS, The City of Cameron solicited bids for renovating the t-hangars, the maintenance hangar and the large box hangar at the Cameron Memorial Airport and did receive three (3) bids; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron has been approved for Non-Primary Entitlement grant money to make airport improvements through the Missouri Department of Transportation, Aviation Department; and

WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the City of Cameron and the Consultant, having reviewed the bids received and determined Luke Kush's Painting, Inc has met all the requirements, provided all necessary documents and was the lowest and best bid with a total base bid of \$330,808.00, recommends approval of an Agreement for Services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with Luke Kush's Painting, Inc to perform services related to hangar renovations with a base bid cost of \$330,808; all as per the agreement attached hereto and made apart hereof.

Section 2. City Manager is hereby authorized to sign any ancillary documents and change orders up to ten percent of base bid as necessary.

Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign this Ordinance on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
