

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-18, MAYOR'S DUTIES, OF CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI REGARDING QUALIFICATIONS OF PERSONS SEEKING APPOINTMENTS TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, Missouri law and the Code of the City of Cameron, Missouri grants the authority to appoint persons to boards and commissions of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cameron, Missouri desires to ensure that all persons seeking appointment to boards and commissions of the City meet the qualifications set forth in the Cameron City Code and possess the necessary knowledge and skill to carry out their appointments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2-18, Mayor's duties, of Chapter 2, Administration, of the Cameron City Code is amended by adding subsection c to read as follows:

Sec. 2-18.- Mayor's duties.

(c) When required by law, the Mayor, with the approval of the Council, shall appoint appropriate persons who meet the qualifications of Sec 2-81 of this Code to boards, commissions, and committees of the City with reference to their fitness for such office. Appointees to all boards, commission, and committees of the City shall, prior to their approval by the Council, execute the City's Code of Ethics and Conduct and provide the same to the City Clerk. The Mayor may, by and with the approval of the Council, remove any person appointed to a board, commission, and committee for misconduct or neglect of duty.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. The Mayor is authorized to sign this ordinance approving it on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
