

AN ORDINANCE TO RESCIND ORDINANCE #6081 AND TO INSTEAD AWARD THE BID FOR HANGAR RENOVATION IMPROVEMENTS AT THE CAMERON MEMORIAL AIRPORT, RELATED TO PROJECT No. 18-013A-1, TO HERNER CONSTRUCTION, INC, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HERNER CONSTRUCTION, INC, FOR SAME

WHEREAS, The City Council approved Ordinance #6081 to award and approve an agreement with Luke Kush Painting, Inc and Luke Kush Painting, Inc was unable to provide documents and execute said agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron needs to rescind Ordinance #6081 with Luke Kush Painting, Inc and award the bid to Herner Construction, Inc; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron has been approved for additional Non-Primary Entitlement grant money for the additional cost through the Missouri Department of Transportation Aviation Department; and

WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the City of Cameron and our Consultant, Jviation, having reviewed the Herner Construction bid and determined they have met all the requirements, provided all necessary documents and were the next lowest bid with a total base bid of \$474,009.60, recommends award and approval of an Agreement for Services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with Herner Construction, Inc to perform services related to hangar renovations with a base bid cost of \$474,009.60.

Section 2. City Manager is hereby authorized to sign any ancillary documents and change orders up to ten percent of the base bid as necessary.

Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign this Ordinance approving it on behalf of the City of Cameron, Missouri.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.
