

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF CAMERON AND THE DEKALB COUNTY COMMISSION AND DEKALB COUNTY COLLECTOR FOR TAX COLLECTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cameron, Missouri desires to enter into a cooperative agreement with the DeKalb County Commission and DeKalb County Collector to collect the taxes for the City of Cameron, Missouri on property located within the DeKalb County portion of the city limits of the City of Cameron; and

WHEREAS, a collective agreement to collect taxes of the City of Cameron is authorized by Sections 70.220, 50.322 and 140.670 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Missouri.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to execute the agreement with the DeKalb County Commission and the DeKalb County Collector attached hereto and made a part hereof for the collection of the City of Cameron’s personal and real estate property taxes.

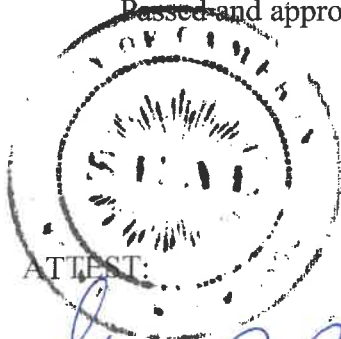
Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to sign this Ordinance approving it on behalf of the City of Cameron, Missouri.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to attest to the Mayor’s signature.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into this **15** day of **July, 2019**, by and between Jessica Lee, Collector/Treasurer of the County of DeKalb, State of Missouri, hereinafter referred to as the First Party, and the City of Cameron, a municipal corporation, of the County of DeKalb, State of Missouri, hereinafter referred to as Second Party.

WHEREAS, The First Party is the duly elected and serving Collector and Treasurer of DeKalb County, and the Second Party is a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri in the County of DeKalb, and

WHEREAS, Second Party desires First Party to bill and collect current and delinquent city taxes assessed by County Assessor; in accordance with First Party's standard operating procedure as established by the Statutes of the State of Missouri for the collection of current taxes.

As compensation for services to First Party, Second Party agrees that First Party shall retain collector's commission at 2.5% (two and one-half percent) on current collections, 3.5% (three and one-half percent) on delinquent collections, plus an assessor's commission at 1.7% (one and seven-tenths percent) on any current and delinquent taxes collected.

First Party shall, upon the collection of any current and delinquent taxes, deduct from said sum the commissions for collection, and remit the balance to the Second Party. Remittance shall be released to Second Party before the 10th of each month for taxes collected the prior month.

First Party shall not be obligated to Second Party, nor does First Party guarantee the collection of any amount of taxes so certified, but First Party merely agrees to exercise such collection practices as are sound and in accordance with state law for the collection of current and delinquent taxes.


This agreement shall be a continuing agreement as long as First Party remains in the Office of Collector and Treasurer of DeKalb County, Missouri, but may be cancelled by either party, giving written notice to the other party of their intention to cancel the agreement by December 1st in any calendar year during the term of First Party's Office.


