Public participation

Treasurer's Report:

Treasury report handed out and discussed.

Directors Report:

There was an offer for a donation to the Parks, current options and prices for memorial benches and trees were passed along.

Swimming Pool parking lot- Due to water main project and contractors using the parking lot for storage and staging area, the parking lot needs another chip and seal. The contractor for the water main project has proposed a 60/40 split, with the Parks Department spending up to a maximum of \$2880.00, out of the Capital Fund. No objections from Board for this proposal.

There are preliminary discussions by the City Council to eliminate people or organizations soliciting in public right-of-ways, and the option of the Park Board including Park properties was presented. The Board was not interested in including any park grounds.

The hand-out of the preliminary YMCA marketing survey showed favorable results for expanding recreational activities in Cameron.

The issue of the parking lot at the Park Valley Baseball Complex/ Parkview Elementary was discussed. Since this area potentially gets more traffic than some city streets, there may be a need to put down a lane width of asphalt and extend the sidewalk. There has also been some patching of areas of the road through Recreational Park due to the heavy rains. Will also look at putting new surface on this road the year.

The YMCA informed the City that starting this season all pool parties would need to provide their own liability insurance. This could potentially limit the number of parties at the pool this year. The Pool will be open from 1-5 pm on the 4th of July.

There were no new actions or issues at the Soccer Complex/Skate Park to discuss.

Old Business

There was none to be discussed

New Business

Discussion on next year's overall budget and request for Board to think of Capital Improvement projects for next year's budget. Such as, Earl Park expansion or a play structure at the Soccer Complex/ Skate Park.

Swimming Pool

The pool has been painted, completely filled, chemicals put in and ready to open Saturday, May 29, 2010.
