The City Council of the City of Cameron, Missouri met in Special Session on Monday, the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April 2009, at five o'clock p.m. at City Hall. Mayor Larry L. Minutes of the April 6, 2009, meeting were approved as submitted with a unanimous voice vote on motion made by Councilmember Stoebener and seconded by Councilmember Jack.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Bill 2009-35, AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON 7 APRIL 2009, FOR COUNCILMEMBERS, IN THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI, was read by title by City Clerk O'Connor. Copies of said Bill 2009-35 were available for the public. Motion was made by Councilmember Stoebener and seconded by Councilmember Jack to pass said bill on first reading. Discussion. Motion carried unanimously.

"Nay" none. The Mayor thereupon declared said bill duly adopted and said bill was numbered **ORDINANCE 5504**, was thereupon signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.
