The City Council of the City of Cameron, Missouri met in Joint Session with the Cameron Planning and Zoning Commission on Monday, the 23rd day of February 2009, at five o'clock p.m. at City Hall. Mayor Larry L. McCord, Jr. presided over the Council with the following Councilmembers present: Dennis M. Clark, Everett W. Ice, Ronnie Jack and Artis Stobener. Absent: none. Planning and Zoning Chairman Mike O'Donnell presided over the Planning and Zoning Commission with the following Commissioners present: Jeanette Copeman, Mark Garges, Stan Hendrix, JoAnn Hiner and George Pratt. Absent: Delvin Jackson.

Present were City Manager David Watson, Attorney for the City Mitch Elliott and City Clerk Barbara J. O'Connor.

Presentation of City of Cameron Cameron Comprehensive Plan 2030 – Bucher, Willis Ratliff. Scott Michie, Bucher, Willis and Ratliff (BWR), presented the Comprehensive Plan to all in attendance. Mr. Michie said nearly 500 citizens had participated in the various work shops that were held. BWR was pleased with the consensus of the public at large at the Planning and Zoning Session. Mr. Michie said a survey taken affirmed the results of the work sessions. Mayor McCord asked for recommendations as how the City should pursue the Plan. Mr. Michie responded the plan is a guide and should be referred to often. The Plan has been endorsed by the Cameron Park Board, the Cameron R-1 School District and the Cameron Regional Medical

Center. It is hoped the Plan will be useful with the regional water supply issue being discussed by communities in Northwest Missouri.

Councilmember Clark inquired about why the Plan stated that only two (2) out of ten (10) citizens have a high school education and asked that the Plan clarify when census data that included the correctional facilities had been used. Commission Carr stated the information should be presented so as not to skew the report.

Planning and Zoning Chairman O'Donnell stated he is pleased with the document noting it will give the Commission guidance in doing their job by knowing public opinion on issues. Commissioner Garges stated the Plan is a working document, a blue print to work with. Mayor McCord noted the document will provide direction for the future.

Unfinished Business (Planning and Zoning Commission)

Resolution 2009-1, **A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE "CITY OF CAMERON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN 2030" BY THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI** was read by title by City Clerk O'Connor. Copies of the Planning and Zoning Commission Resolution 2009-1 were available for the public. Commissioner Hendrix moved to pass Resolution 2009-1 adopting the "City of Cameron Comprehensive Plan 2030". Commissioner Pratt seconded the motion. Discussion. Chairman O'Donnell asked the Commissioners to raise their right hand if they approve Resolution 2009-1. Resolution 2009-1 passed with a unanimous hand vote.

Unfinished Business (City of Cameron)

Bill 2009-11, **AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI ADOPTING THE "CITY OF CAMERON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN 2030"**, was read by title by City Clerk O'Connor. Copies of said Bill 2009-11 were available for the public. Motion was made by Councilmember Stoebener and seconded by Councilmember Ice to pass said bill on first reading. Discussion. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Councilmember Jack and seconded by Councilmember Clark to suspend the rules and place said bill on second reading. Discussion. None. Motion carried unanimously.

On motion made by Councilmember Stoebener and seconded by Councilmember Ice said bill was placed on second reading, was read by title and passed by the following roll call vote: "Aye": Councilmembers: Clark, Ice, Jack, McCord and Stoebener. "Nay" none. The Mayor thereupon declared said bill duly adopted and said bill was numbered **ORDINANCE 5480**, was thereupon signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned with a unanimous voice vote at 5:40 p.m. on motion made by Councilmember Clark and seconded by Councilmember Jack.

There being no further business to come before the Planning and Zoning Commission, the meeting was adjourned with a unanimous hand vote at 5:40 p.m. on motion made by Commissioner Hendrix and seconded by Commissioner Hiner.
