

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI TO ENTER INTO A LEASE WITH GARY O'GRADY FOR THE USE OF AGRICULTURAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 521 S ELM

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron owns various properties in the Cameron area that have agricultural value, including the location at 521 S Elm, known as the Cameron Dog Pound; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to lease the property for limited use of cutting and baling of hay; and

WHEREAS, the City went through a formal competitive bid process; and Gary O'Grady, as the successful bidder, desires to lease the approximate eight acres at the Dog Pound pursuant to the Lease Agreement, the form of which is attached as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to lease properties at fair market value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DEKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Gary O'Grady for the lease of hay ground at the Dog Pound, all as per the agreement attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute ancillary documents necessary to effect this transaction.

Section 3. The Mayor is authorized to sign this Ordinance approving it on behalf of the City of Cameron.

Section 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
