The City Council of the City of Cameron, Missouri met in Special Session on Thursday, the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May 2008, at five o'clock p.m. at City Hall. Mayor Larry L. McCord, Jr. presided with the following Councilmembers present: Dennis M. Clark, Everett W. Ice and Artis Stobener. Absent: none. *Note: one open seat.*

Present were City Manager Phillip R. Lammers, Attorney for the City Mitch Elliott and City Clerk Barbara J. O'Connor.

Bill 2008-26, AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON 13 MAY 2008, FOR COUNCILMEMBER, IN THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI, was read by title by City Clerk O'Connor. Copies of said Bill 2008-26 were available for the public. Motion was made by Councilmember Stobener and seconded by Councilmember Clark to pass said bill on first reading. Discussion. City Clerk O'Connor stated there were a total of 559 votes cast with Ronnie Jack receiving 370 and Mark Garges receiving 189 votes. Mr. Jack will be commissioned as a Councilmember following approval of this Bill. Motion carried unanimously. *Note: one open seat.*

Motion was made by Councilmember Clark and seconded by Councilmember Stobener to suspend the rules and place said bill on second reading. Discussion. None. Motion carried unanimously. *Note: one open seat.*

On motion made by Councilmember Ice and seconded by Councilmember Clark said bill was placed on second reading, was read by title and passed by the following roll call vote: "Aye": Councilmembers: Clark, Ice, McCord and Stobener. "Nay" none. *Note: one vacant seat.* The Mayor thereupon declared said bill duly adopted and said bill was numbered **ORDINANCE 5430**, was thereupon signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk. *Note: one open seat.*

Oath of Office Administered to Ronnie Jack. City Clerk O'Connor administered the oath of office to Ronnie Jack.

Election of Mayor and Mayor Pro-Tem. City Clerk O'Connor entertained nominations for election of Mayor. Councilmember Stoebener nominated Councilmember McCord. Councilmember Clark seconded the nomination. Councilmember McCord was elected Mayor by a unanimous voice vote. Mayor McCord entertained nominations for election of Mayor Pro-Tem. Councilmember Clark nominated Councilmember Ice. Councilmember Jack seconded the nomination. Councilmember Ice was elected Mayor Pro-Tem by a unanimous voice vote.
