

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF CAMERON, CLINTON AND DeKALB COUNTIES, MISSOURI AMENDING SUBSECTION (A) OF SECTION 12-138. SERVICE DEPOSITS, OF DIVISION 4. METERS OF ARTICLE II, WATER, AND SECTION 12-306. DEPOSIT, SERVICE FEES AND CHARGES OF DIVISION 1. GENERALLY, OF ARTICLE IV. ELECTRICITY, OF CHAPTER 12, WATER, SEWAGE AND ELECTRICITY OF THE CITY OF CAMERON CODE, CHANGING THE DEPOSITS FOR ELECTRIC AND WATER SERVICE

WHEREAS, the City of Cameron is impacted by incremental increases in the cost of operations in the utility services; and

WHEREAS, the City has incurred additional unfunded liabilities from utility customers by virtue of payment after services are rendered; and

WHEREAS, the average cost remaining in unpaid utility accounts has increased since deposits were last adjusted in 2005.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the City Council of the City of Cameron, Clinton and DeKalb Counties, Missouri shall make the following changes to the City of Cameron Code:

Section 1. Subsection (a) of Section 12-138. Service deposits, of Division 4. Meters of Article II, Water, of Chapter 12, Water, Sewage and Electricity of the City of Cameron Code is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 12-138. Service deposits.

- (a) There shall be required a cash deposit for all customers of water and sewer service to protect the City against loss. For residential customers the deposit shall be seventy-five dollars (\$75), for small commercial customers (see Sec. 12-322) one hundred dollars (\$100), and for large commercial customers (See Sec. 12-324) at 1.5 times the average monthly bill.

Section 2. Amend subsection (a)(1). Of Division 1. Generally, of Article IV. Electricity, of Chapter 12, Water, Sewage and Electricity of the City of Cameron Code as follows:

Sec. 12-306. Deposit, service fees and charges.

- (a) A deposit fee shall be required and collected from all persons for electric connections as follows:
 - (1) One hundred fifty dollars (\$150) for each electrical connection to a family residence.

(2) Two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) for a small commercial (see Sec. 12-322) establishment.

(3) One and one-half times (1.5) the average monthly bill for large commercial (see Sec. 12-324) customers.

Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign this ordinance.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
